Finally, I know that summer can sometimes feel like a break from routines, but our spiritual growth doesn't have to take a vacation! Here are some ideas to help you stay rooted in faith and connected to our church, no matter where your travels take you:

* Worship In-Person and Online: Even if you're out of town, you can still join us for Sunday worship! We will continue to offer in-person services at our regular time. Additionally, our online worship services will be available, allowing you to participate from anywhere with an internet connection. Don't forget that many UMC churches across the country also offer worship both online and in-person – a great way to experience different expressions of faith! Remember to share your experiences and any ideas when you return!

* Intentional Prayer: Make prayer a daily practice. Whether you have a dedicated prayer time or simply offer up short prayers throughout your day, fostering a direct connection with God is essential. Consider keeping a prayer journal to reflect on your conversations with God. Don't forget to lift our church, its leadership, and its ministries in your prayers.

* UMC Discipleship "Read a Chapter a Day" Program: The United Methodist Church offers a fantastic "Read a Chapter a Day" program, often focusing on specific books of the Bible. This summer, from June 9th to July 26th, the program will guide participants through Romans, 1 Corinthians, and 2 Corinthians.
